The deadline for Abstracts (oral and poster presentations) is **15th April 2019**. The Scientific Committee will review all abstracts and release their decision for acceptance by **7th May 2019**.

Oral and poster presentations will be published in the Book of Abstracts only if at least one of the authors has registered for the Congress.

Poster

Posters size must be 80 cm wide x 100 cm long and will be fixed on the Thursday morning. At least one of the authors should be present during the whole time of poster session.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Congress venue is centrally located in Alghero in the Hotel Catalunya, Via Catalogna, 22. Alghero is an important tourist destination of Sardinia and overlooks the homonymous bay. Its territory has been inhabited since the Neolithic, as evidenced by the various necropolises found. The real city of Alghero was founded by the Doria of Genoa between 1102 and 1112. Later it was sold by the Doria to the Aragonesi, then the Catalan colonization took place, whose cultural influence has reached our days. Alghero, in fact, has preserved the Catalan language and cultural tradition even when in 1720 Sardinia passed from the Aragonesi to the Kingdom of the House of Savoy. The Congress will start on the afternoon of Wednesday 19th with two plenary lectures and will continue on Thursday 20th and Friday 21th with further plenary lectures, short lectures, poster presentations. The official language is English; no simultaneous translation will be provided. Additional information is available on the Congress website from the end of February 2019.
